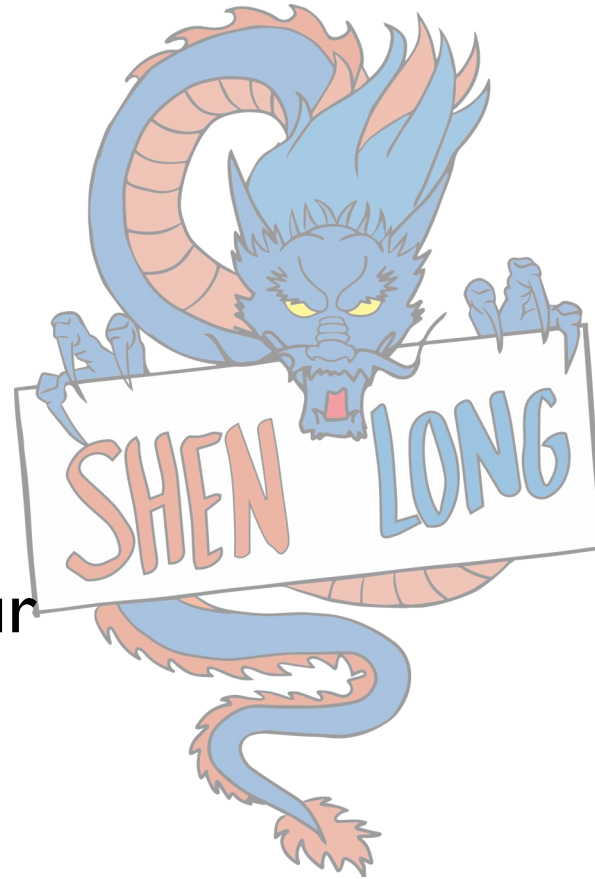

Financial Business - Costs

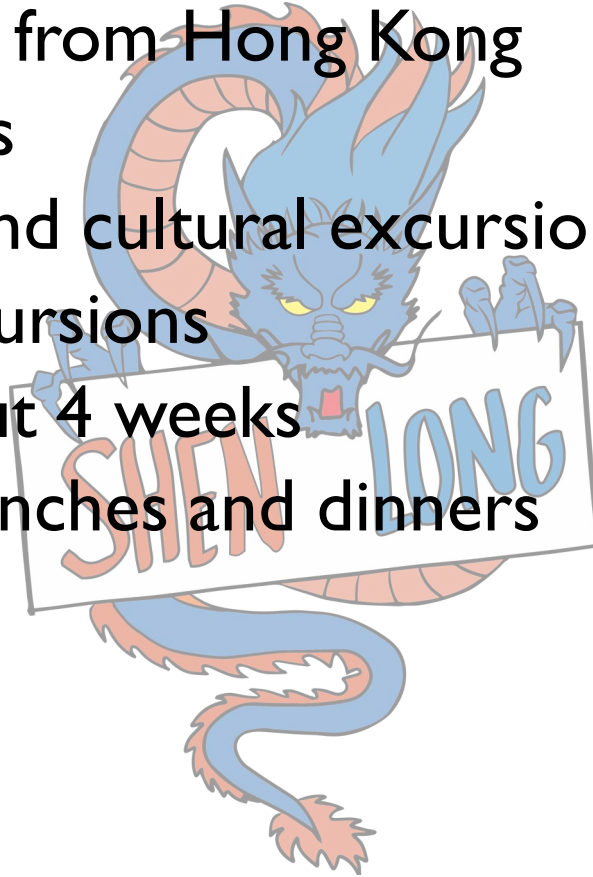
- The costs are mentioned at the Thor website at the enrollment page for the study tour

Shanghai

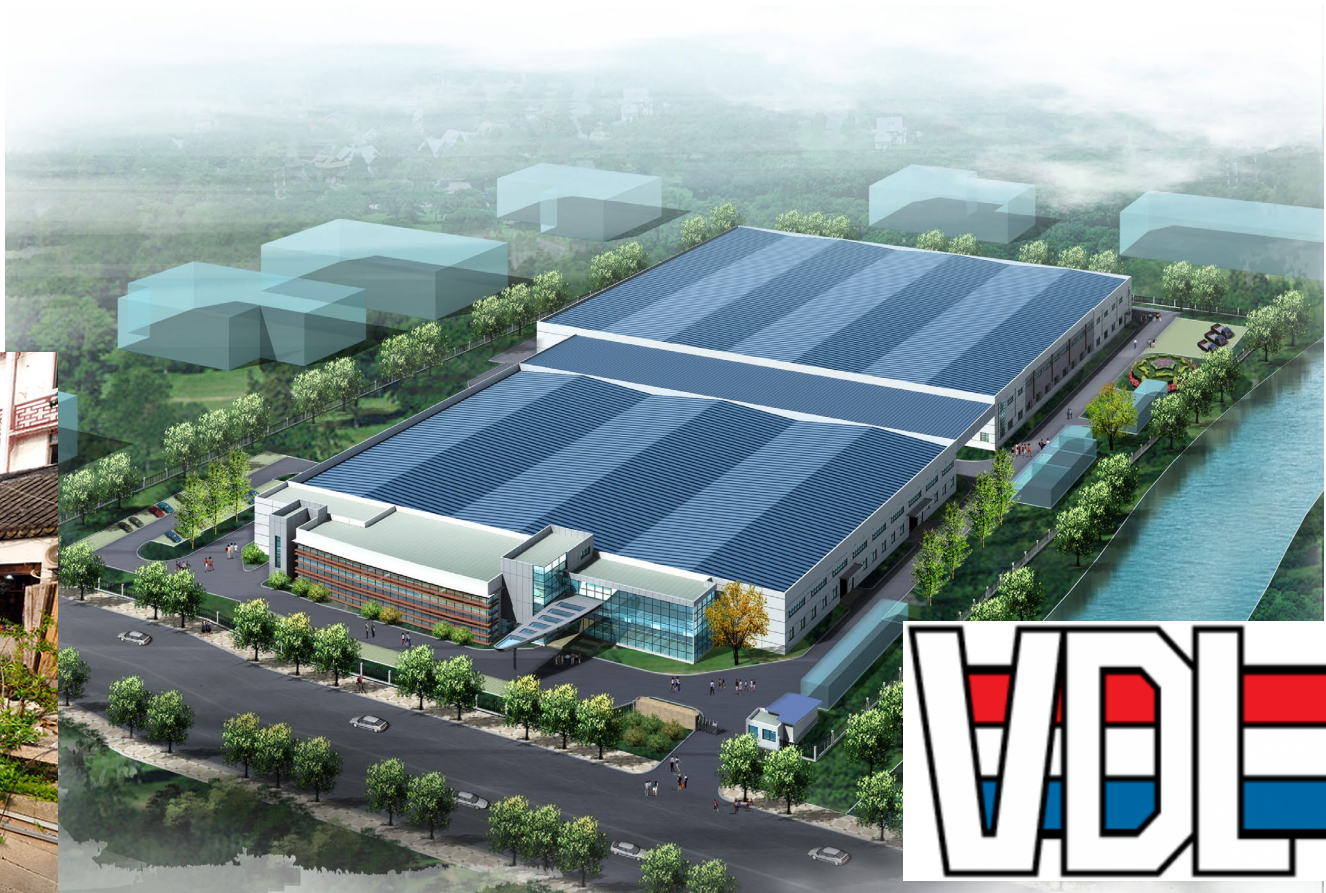
- Largest city in China

Shenzhen



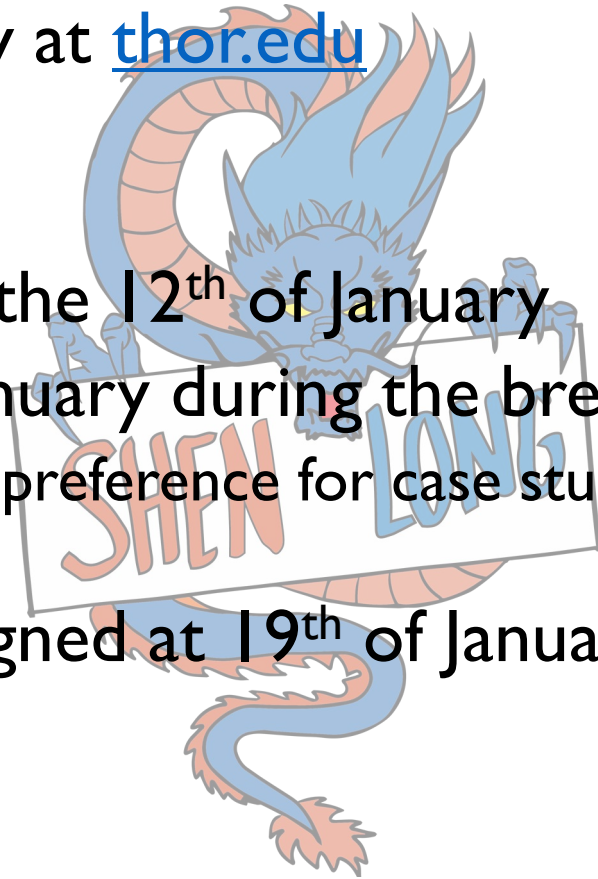
- At the border with Hong Kong
